- II. Old Business:
 - Secretary Vacancy
 - The Secretary vacancy is still open.
 - Scholarships
 - Scholarships are due May 1st.
 - It's on the website.
 - An email will be sent to all seniors.
 - Advertisement Requests
 - Update the bridge bulletin with graduation stoles and senior signs have been sent to Mrs. Viviann.
 - VABC funds support the athletic team.
 - An email was sent to all coaches. The deadline for funds request is May 1st.
 - Football's request was received.
 - Crew will have their request in but will be @ Stotesberry on the 14th and will not be able to attend but Jen Pereira will advocate on their behalf.

- III. Treasurer Report
 - February had a dip because of the \$6,000 for the scoreboard.
 - March trended favorably up.
 - with Spirit wear purchase and Spring Concessions starting
 - Pepsi Scholarship Donations
 - Contact at Pepsi is no longer there.
 - Need to reach out to Pepsi to find out who to contact.
 - 24-25 Donations hit this year, so technically there's \$2,000 allocated for scholarships.

- IV. Spirit Store
 - A small batch of shirts were ordered in March to fill the holes and gaps to get us through the end of the year and help us start strong next school year. The order has already been delivered to the school and will be put on the shelves next week.
 - Need to get the "Word Out" that Graduation Stoles and Senior Yard Signs are available in the school store every Friday at Lunch.

V. Concessions

- Gojekian (Track meet) tomorrow 4/10/26, parents and students are signed up to help.
- Stadium Sports and Volunteer Issues
 - Stadium sports are slow in the spring, with games almost every night of the week lacking volunteers.
 - Yanci, the "soccer mom," is tired and has been working long hours.
 - Signs have been put up stating, "If you want concessions open, we need parent support. Concessions run off of parents."
 - A jumbo-sized sign with a QR code will be placed on the window when concessions are closed, saying, "Need concessions, Please volunteer."
 - Jen will create a "Sign Up Genius" for every night so people can see when and where they can volunteer.
- Concession Profits and Volunteer Tracking
 - Concession profits do not go to the specific sport being played.
 - The board does track who helps with concessions and who attends board meetings
- Fall Sports and Volunteer Strategy
 - The crew team has offered to help get more parent volunteers.
 - Football is the most profitable event in the fall.
 - Varsity boys football teams do concessions for JV and vice versa, with one parent overseeing.
 - For most regular games, board members check in every 20 minutes, but on high profile games Homecoming , Senior Night and Play-offs it is an "all hands on deck" situation.
- Winter Sports Volunteer Help
 - Battle bridge required a lot of work, with one person working 13 hours one day and 12 hours the next with limited help.
 - There's a need for more emphasis on concessions for winter sports.
 - Some sports get no volunteer help at all.

- Crew Magnets
 - Coach Mazer wants the kids to be able to get the magnets where they get everything else.
 - Coach is in the market of getting the "Word Out" about WSHS Crew because it's one of the only sports like lacrosse & field hockey, where you might start freshman year of high school.

- Middle School Outreach
- Crew used to support the rowing club @ middle schools but doesn't anymore. The Team is working on getting back into the MS's. Mr. Dutro, the principal at Lake Ridge, is a Woodbridge grad and a good resource.
- Grill on the Hill:
 - In the past, donated drinks were provided.
 - Need to talk to Pepsi.

- Dunk Tank:

 - Cost would be \$3-\$5 per ball.
 - Need to get a quote for renting the dunk tank, coordinate with the school for logistics and recruit teachers/coaches – Kristen Taylor will spearhead.
